

According to the guidelines of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education, the Editors of the Journal require the paper Authors to disclose:

- all authors who have contributed to the creation of the publication (giving their names and affiliation) and
- sources of publication funding.

An author submitting a paper is fully responsible for any events of:

- plagiarism
- “ghostwriting” (a significant contribution to the publication of a person whose name is not mentioned among the authors or whose role is not mentioned in the acknowledgements following the publication)
- “guest authorship” (no contribution to the creation of the publication of a person mentioned as an author or co-author).

It is the Editors’ duty to expose and document all signs of breach of the standard principles of scientific ethics and to report all events of such breach to the appropriate authorities.
